This letter is to inform you of the procedures for CERTIFICATE OF RESIDENCY FORMS. This procedure has been in effect for almost a year, however there are still many questions on this.

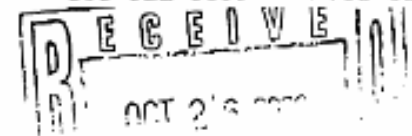
As we all move toward the paperless society The State is decreasing the amount of paper that is flowing around the state. The Department of Children and Families no longer sends the County a copy of the Certificate of Residency form, instead it is done electronically and printed on the invoice. DCF has certified that the address on the invoice is the Recipients last legal residence address. To inform the counties that the invoice has the correct address on it you will see "no cor" in the transactions explanation field, this means that you the county will not receive a cor. If this shows on the invoice the address has been certified by DCF and the bill should be paid. If certified charges continue to be denied and unpaid we will be required to take further actions to collect this money.
